

Application Timing

Evenly apply BLUEPRINT Powder directly to the seed as close as possible to planting.

Application Mixtures

BLUEPRINT Powder is best applied with a talc/graphite application. BLUEPRINT does not replace talc/graphite. Do not mix BLUEPRINT Powder with water solution.

Application Methods

Single Row Unit

Add seed to row unit. Using scoop, add the appropriate amount of BLUEPRINT Powder on top of seed. Stir seed gently to mix.

Bulk Method

- **Metered Applicator:** Add BLUEPRINT Powder at recommended rate along with talc/graphite to a metered applicator on seed tender to coat seed
- **Center fill hopper:** Add BLUEPRINT Powder at recommended rate as seed is added to the hopper, either at the hopper or at the base of the auger
- **Box-to-box:** add BLUEPRINT Powder to a dry box-to-box seed treater. Or, apply on top of seed in box and pour seed into an empty box to ensure sufficient mixing

Crop: Row Crops

Crop safe: Confirmed by multiple seasons of field trials.

Storage and disposal: Protect from direct sunlight and store in a dark, dry and cool place between 5-25°C (40-77°F). Do not refrigerate or freeze.

Application Use Rate

Planter Box: 0.85 oz/ac or 25 g
1 pouch covers 40 acres

Common Acres	Approx. Quantity
1 (~1 bag soybean)	½ scoop
2.5 (~1 bag corn)	1 scoop
10	4 scoops
40	1 pouch
120 ac (~Corn Pro box)	3 pouches



BLUEPRINT Powder is compatible with:

- Seed treatment fungicides/pesticides (Apron, Maxim, Cruiser & Avicta, etc.)

Don't apply BLUEPRINT Powder with:

- Seed treatments that contain systemic fungicides
- Soil applied fungicides
- Starter phosphorus rates above 75 units of P/ac
